Baptism.



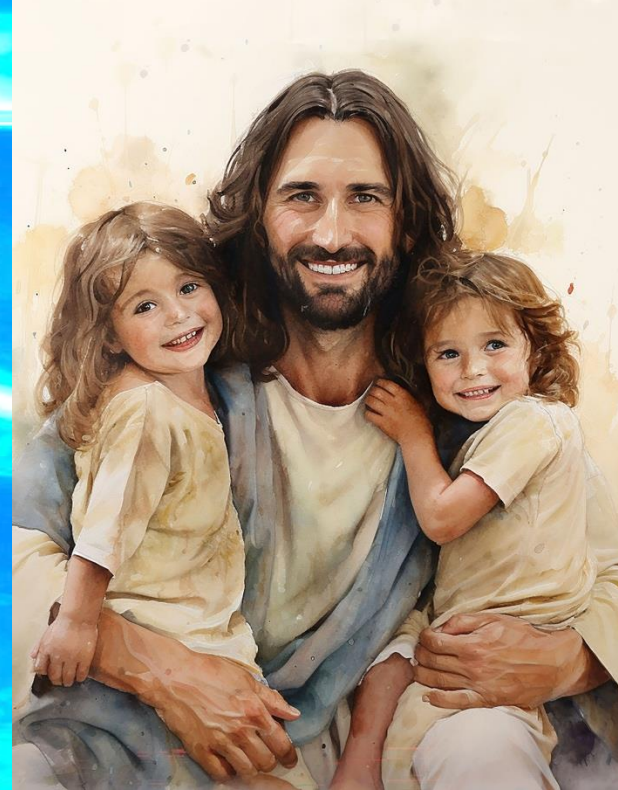
Sara and Andrew do you

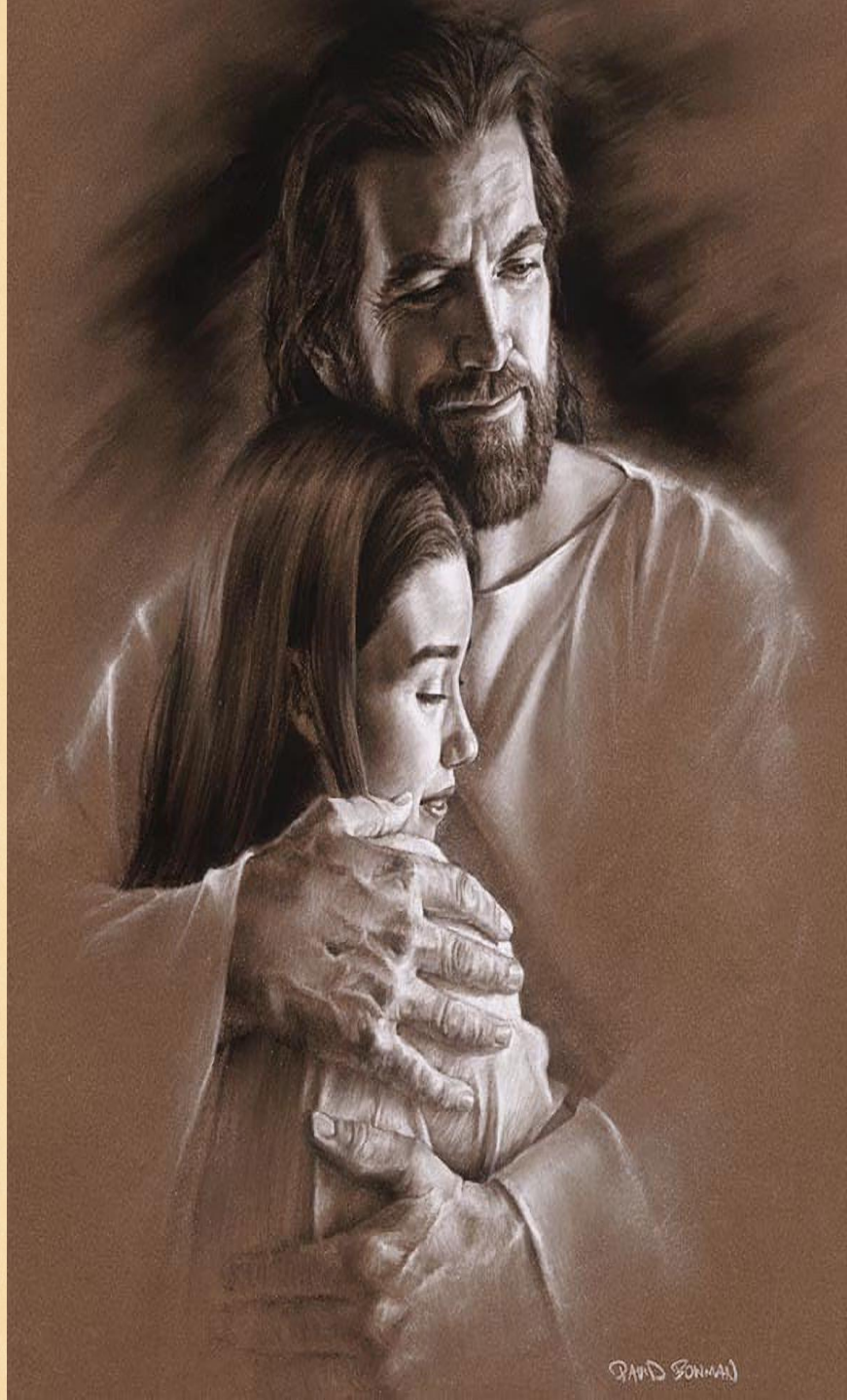
