


















O for a thousand tongues to sing my great Redeemer's praise, the glories of my God and King, the triumphs of his grace.




Jesus! the name that charms our fears, that bids our sorrows cease, 'tis music in the sinner's ears, 'tis life and health and peace.


For those imprisoned by the notion that they are not welcome in God's family, send them witnesses who will extend Your welcome as they are.




For those who are blind to Your love, give them the opportunity to see Your love in how believers act.




